Students at Cooktown P-12 State School in Year 3, Year 5, Year 7 and Year 9 will be participating this year in the annual National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN). This year, NAPLAN will be run online. Online means that students will take the test online using computers at Cooktown P-12 State School. The NAPLAN Online tests this year will run over the fortnight beginning Tuesday May 12, and will finish on Friday May 22.

NAPLAN Online – information for parents and carers

A NAPLAN Online – information for parents and carers factsheet has been attached to this letter.

Feedback in the first year of NAPLAN Online showed that students engaged well with online assessments. One of the main benefits of NAPLAN Online is tailored (or adaptive) testing, where the test automatically adapts to a student's test performance. The test presents questions of higher or lower complexity, depending on a student's performance.

Tailored (or adaptive) testing is designed to assess a wider range of student abilities and to measure student achievement more precisely. Your child should not be concerned if they find questions more challenging than usual; they may be taking a more complex test pathway. A student's overall NAPLAN score is based on the number and complexity of questions they answer correctly.

Cooktown P-12 State School does not coach or engage in extensive preparation for NAPLAN. We do ensure that our students have the digital literacy skills to successfully engage with the NAPLAN Online tests. Students will have the opportunity to participate in NAPLAN Online practice tests during Week 1 of Term 2.

NAPLAN Online is not a test of keyboard skills. There are variations in how fast and well a student can type – just as there are variations in how fast and well a student can write by hand. Year 3 students will complete the writing test on paper.




From here you can select from the various NAPLAN tests for that year level:








Select Standard test
