2025 STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME (SRS) and SUBJECT FEES

Participation in the **SRS** is voluntary; parents/caregivers are under no obligation to participate, if you choose not to participate please complete a new Participation Agreement Form, indicating this option. If you choose this option, you will need to provide all items on the inclusion list and/or pay the full elective subject fee for the student. A text book list, subject fees and resources supplied is provided as a guide to costs.

SRS fees are payable in full by the end of term 1 unless otherwise negotiated with the school. Please call the office if you are experiencing financial hardship, where a payment plan can be arranged.

Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA)

The school receives a payment called the Textbook and Resource Allowance from the Government.

This allowance is provided to offset the cost of participating in the school's Student Resoruce Scheme.

The 2025 rate for this allowance is:

Years 7 to 10 \$160.00 per student per annum

Years 11 and 12 \$348.00 per student per annum

Without receiving this allowance the cost of participating in the scheme would be:
